- -Trying to get stop sign up on Rochester street and get a few loads of stone
- -Pot holes will be taken care of Wednesday
- -Work will also be done on Princeton near the Gleason's house
- -Tree came down on a boat during the storm on Saturday. Tree came down and the boat will need major repairs. Lisa called the insurance agency. Insurance agency asked many questions about the tree. Photos were sent to the insurance agency. Lisa is waiting to hear back. She will speak to Jeff

Slocum to see if Liberty Tree did any work on it. Last August David Stanborrow spoke at a board meeting about concerns about the tree. Board agreed that it should be removed. An estimate was going to be obtained.

Boat 1 -Canopy cover got ripped and one of the ribs was bent

Boat 2- Hall and engine look ok - but windshield and dashboard was damaged

Boat 3- Limb fell on the seat. Seat looked ok.

Boat 4- had limbs and branches on the boat with no damage

All members from boat 1-4 are in good standing with the association. Do they own the boats? May come after the association. Questions about who owns the land. We have to be prepared that the insurance company will only cover the tree removal and not the property damage. We had 70 mph winds during the storm when the tree came down. Tree was brought up by a member at a previous meeting.

Do we have the trees removed? Keep the root ball so that the shoreline is not disturbed. Talk Liberty to see what they think and get a second opinion from another company. What are the conditions of all of these trees? We need to make some decisions based on what happens with this situation.

Information will be provided to the association that we are being proactive moving forward and will get some type of an assessment for the shoreline.

Shoreline -

- -We are almost at flood level so the DEC most likely will not give us the permit right now. Lisa will reach out to Seawall by Wednesday.
- -We will have another update next month.
- -Is there access to a shoreline email? Keith needs access to email. We need to give another email to the shoreline. (shoreline@hlpany.com)
 This information will be posted in glass boxes.

- -Pins were driven in for GPS on the shoreline every 40-60 feet. Once the shoreline is finished, markers will be created that will show the exact measurements of where the slip space is (-10 feet plus 4 feet from the center of the dock). Slip spaces will be numbered for members docks. Members may need to move right or left. We do not want to move anyone too far from their current space.
- -Order of people on the waiting list is on "Shoreline-News" Some members on current list are not in "good standing".
- -Job for Keith will be to find a way to mark spaces at ground level.
